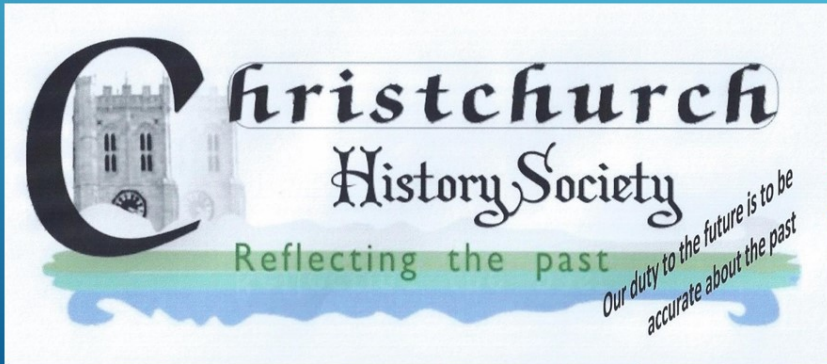


HOW TO CARRY OUT A SEARCH USING THE ON-LINE CATALOGUE OF



The purpose of these Guidance Notes is to assist the users of the Christchurch History Society Archive On-Line Catalogue in a ten step guide.

STEP 1

The search of the On-Line Catalogue starts from the 'Home Page' where in the Page Header Tab Bar click on "**Catalogue**"



STEP 2

On the On-Line Catalogue 'Search the Archive Page' there is a **"Search Box"** on the left hand side into which can be entered any word(s) on which a search is required. Beneath the **"Search Box"** there are a number of filters that will be used to refine the search in due course.

For an example enter 'Christchurch' into the **"Search Box"** and click on **"Search"**

This will take you back to the On-Line Catalogue 'Search the Archive Page' but the number of entries on the page will have reduced to 3535. This number needs to be filtered to a more manageable number and can be done by using one or more of five possible filters within the On-Line Catalogue 'Search the Archive Page'

STEP 3

The first thing to notice is that the On-Line Catalogue ‘Search the Archive Page’ informs you that you searched and / or filtered on ‘Christchurch’ to obtain the list that is currently displayed

The next filter beneath the "Search Box" that can now be used to refine the search is **"Filter by Subject"**, the chosen filter word can be found in the drop down menu. See Appendix B on Page 15.

For an example, click on 'Harbour' in the **"Filter by Subject Box"**

This will take you back to the On-Line Catalogue 'Search the Archive Page' but the number of entries on the page will have reduced to 6. This number can be filtered further if considered necessary using another of three possible filters within the On-Line Catalogue 'Search the Archive Page' or go to STEP 8

If thought necessary the next filter beneath the "Search Box" that can now be used to refine the search is "**Filter by Format**", the chosen filter word can be found in the drop down menu. See Appendix C on Page 17.

For an example, click on 'Photograph' in the "**Filter by Format Box**"

This will take you back to the On-Line Catalogue 'Search the Archive Page' but the number of entries on the page will have reduced to 5. This number does not need to be filtered but can be, using the other two possible filters within the On-Line Catalogue 'Search the Archive Page' or go to STEP 8

STEP 6

If thought necessary the next filter beneath the “Search Box” that can now be used to refine the search is **“Filter by Century”**, the chosen filter century can be found in the drop down menu. See Appendix D on Page 18

For an example, click on ‘20th’ in the **“Filter by Century Box”**



This will take you back to the On-Line Catalogue ‘Search the Archive Page’ but the number of entries on the page will have reduced to 2. This number does not need to be filtered but can be using the last of the possible filters within the On-Line Catalogue ‘Search the Archive Page’ or go to STEP 8

STEP 7

Although in this example it is not necessary; if thought necessary the next filter beneath the “Search Box” that can now be used to refine the search is **“Filter by Time Period”**, the chosen filter decade can be found in the drop down menu. . See Appendix D on Page 18

For an example, click on ‘1980s’ in the **“Filter by Time Period Box”**

This will take you back to the On-Line Catalogue ‘Search the Archive Page’ and the item that the search was based upon is located and displayed.

In this example that item could have been found in Steps 5 and 6 and with scrolling through 55 items in Step 4 and clicking on the chosen item that is now displayed in STEP 8

STEP 8

Now displayed is the item on which the Search and Filter has been based and this step is arrived at from either STEP 4, or STEP 5, or STEP 6, or STEP 7, clicking on 'Mudford Quay' under "Title" the full On-Line Catalogue details of the item are displayed.

NOTE

The five filters can be used in any order, or not at all, and the requirement is a choice for the user being dependent upon the unique search being made.

STEP 9



Explanation of Fields in On-Line Catalogue

Field	Description
Title	This is free-text.
Description	This is free-text.
Creator(s)	This is the person who created the original item, for example wrote the document, created a photograph or postcard.
Collection(s)	This is the name of the person or organisation who contributed the item to the Christchurch History Society Archive. <i>This is not shown by the example on the previous page.</i>
Date of Coverage	This is the time period the item covers.
Copyright	This is to provide information as to who owns the copyright of the item.
Reference Number	This is the unique reference number of the item.
Filename	<i>This is only completed for digital records.</i> If the archive is digital then the filename will be shown. <i>This is not shown by the example on the previous page.</i>
Access	This provides information about how the item can be viewed.
License	This provides the conditions under which an individual item is being released through the on-line catalogue. <i>Generally this is CC BY-NC which allows others to remix, tweak, and build on the material non-commercially, and the new work must acknowledge Christchurch History Society.</i>


STEP 10



Appendix A – Controlled Vocabulary for Place

In Step 3 a filtered search can be carried out on “Place” using a controlled vocabulary followed by the Cataloguers.

A single entry has been taken to enable the filter on the search to be effective but if there is more than one place involved, all places have been listed. In the circumstance where the place of the archival material is not known or clear the field has been left blank and a note entered into the ‘Comments’ field. The chosen filter word can be found in the drop down menu of the following places (those “Places” also in “Subject” are shown in Red) :-

Appendix B – Controlled Vocabulary for Subject

In Step 4 a filtered search can be carried out on “Subject” using a controlled vocabulary followed by the Cataloguers.

A single entry from the controlled vocabulary has been taken to enable the filter on the search to be effective. In the extremely rare circumstance where the subject matter of the archival material is not known or clear the field has been left blank and a note entered into the ‘Comments’ field. The chosen filter word can be found in the drop down menu of the following places (those “Subjects” also in “Places” are shown in **Red**) :-

Appendix C – Controlled Vocabulary for Format

In Step 5 a filtered search can be carried out on “Format” using a controlled vocabulary followed by the Cataloguers.

A single entry from the controlled vocabulary has been taken to enable the filter on the search to be effective. In the circumstance where the original format of the archival material is not known or clear the field has been left blank and a note entered into the ‘Comments’ field. The chosen filter word can be found in the drop down menu of the following formats :-
